

Project notification

Transmission Line bank erosion repairs on Albany River near Kashechewan

FNEI will require riprap rock 12” diameter and larger, to build a stream deflector wall.

Most of the riprap rock is located on the Fort Albany side and it will have to be hauled from there by the “short cut” and path way under the transmission line. The gravel for the wall backfill should be taken from across the river from landslide site which is about a 3000 ft travel distance.

FNEI is trying to involve all interested contractors from Fort Albany and Kashechewan and share the work equally.

Please provide rates per load based on the map. Red lines for the Gravel haul, and the Blue lines for hauling the riprap rock. Pit locations in Albany have to be added to the identified route (blue). Please

contact FNEI office with the available volumes of Riprap rock at your pit. It is better to start collecting it in piles ASAP before the frost gets too deep.
