2. Participants must be from Attawapiskat First Nation, Kashechewan First Nation, Fort Albany First Nation, Moose Cree First Nation, or Taykwa Tagamou Nation.
3. Submissions must include your name, mailing address, First Nation band, contact number, child’s age, what grade you’re in. Each participant **must** provide a parent or guardian’s permission slip to participate.
4. Only those whose drawings chosen will be contacted.
5. Five Nations Energy Inc. staff's children/grandchildren may participate.

Subject Matter Guidelines

1. Drawings must be in white, 8.5x11" paper and should be landscape/horizontal orientation.
2. Drawings must depict the theme "Safety Around Electricity"? Be Creative!
3. Drawings are to be sent “full-size.” Do not submit screen shots or images saved from social media. Cell phone photographs must be horizontal/landscape orientation.
4. File size should be at least 2 MB for color.

Voting
